Adoption begins with a traumatic loss and progresses, we hope, to a secure attachment with a new family. The numbers of adopted children and adults in therapy lets us know that somehow this process often goes awry and it is difficult for parents and therapists to understand why this happens. Why do some children, even after years with stable, loving families still show extreme feelings and behaviors? What issues are agencies missing in their preparation of prospective parents during the placement process? In this presentation, we'll take a look at the stresses and losses of adoption, and some ways to help children and families reach secure attachment.
